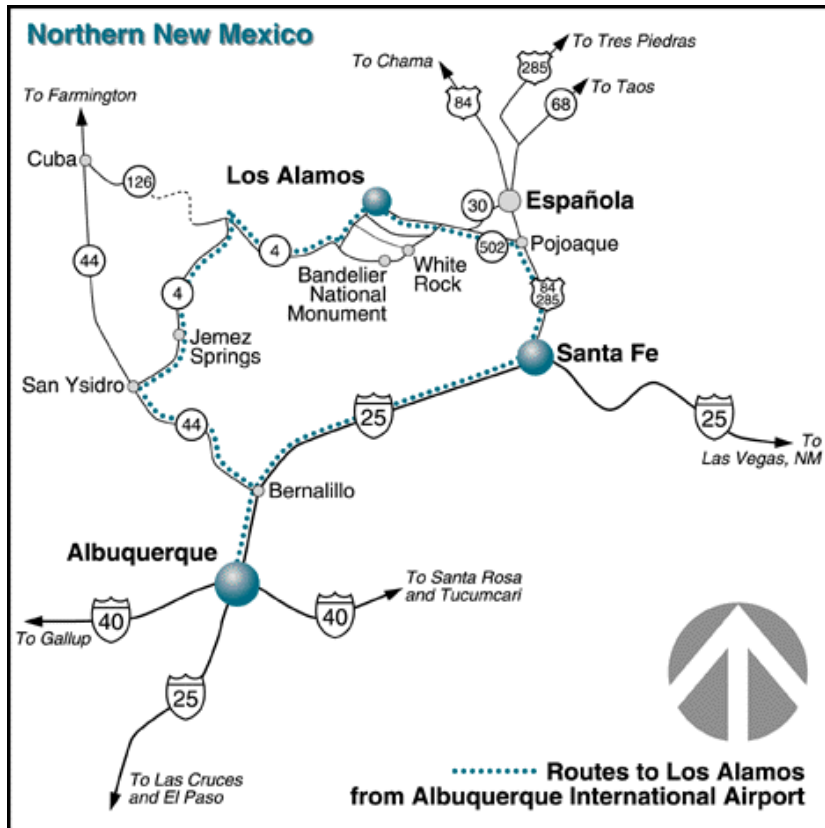

Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. LADOC, its agents, members, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, their dogs, or their property and furthermore assume no responsibility for injury to children present at this trial.

Telegraph, telephone, facsimile, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Should the exhibitor not receive such acknowledgment within a reasonable time, please notify the Trial Secretary.

Make all check and money orders payable to **LADOC. Canadian and Mexican** exhibitors must make their fees payable in U.S. funds. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. Trial Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail. If using special mail arrangements (Express Mail, Federal Express, etc.), please waive signature requirements.

A recording fee of 50 cents and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee will be required for each dog entered in any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Rally Trial. These fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted that specifies any condition to its acceptance.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or banned from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the show-giving club, it is impossible to open or to complete this trial, no refund of entry fees shall be made.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. **A \$25.00 collection fee will be charged for ALL returned checks.** Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in putting the exhibitors on a **CASH-ONLY** basis.

No refund for duplicate entries. Every effort to identify all duplicate entries will be made, however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on entry forms. Owners are responsible for accuracy in making out entries regardless of who completes the entry form. No entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date.

Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging and may be excused when no longer required for further judging.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for presenting their dogs to their assigned ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates except when being judged.

All exhibitors are expected to clean up after their dogs. Those failing to do so will be subject to official action.
